When the positions were created, the coordinator was to manage Grades 7 & 8 only and the Director was to manage Grades 9-12 and overseeing the whole program.

Beth Campbell asked if the Center School drama position is ran by the school or the Opera House.

**Superintendent Francine Coss** replied that there is no stipend for the Center School Drama Coach in the teacher's contract, but the tradition had been for more than two decades, that there was someone to run the program. The position is funded through the monies that come in from the program.
