Memorandum of Agreement

The Thomaston Board of Education (hereinafter the "Board") and the Thomaston Education Association (hereinafter the "Association") agree to the following:

- 1. The Board and the Association are parties to a collective bargaining agreement dated July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2026.
- 2. Ms. Theresa Tortorici (hereinafter "Ms. Tortorici") is a full-time teacher employed by the Board as a Special Education Teacher at Thomaston High School.
- 3. Ms. Tortorici is a member of the Association.
- 4. Ms. Janice Ellis (hereinafter "Ms. Ellis"), a teacher at Thomaston High School, will be out on administrative leave for a period of time during the 2023-2024 school year.
- 5. Commencing on March 20, 2024, Ms. Tortorici has agreed to act as the Teacher of Record for Ms. Ellis's math classes.
- 6. As the Teacher of Record, Ms. Tortorici enters grades and plans lessons for Ms. Ellis's classes.
- 7. Acting as the Teacher of Record for Ms. Ellis's classes has resulted in an additional workload that warrants remuneration equal to teaching one (1) additional course.
- 8. Ms. Tortorici's current per diem rate of pay based on her annual salary of forty-eight thousand three hundred fifty-four dollars (\$48,354.00) is two hundred sixty-four dollars and thirty-seven cents (\$261.37).
- 9. Based on Ms. Tortorici's per diem rate of pay, her daily rate for teaching the equivalent of one (1) additional class is forty-eight dollars and fifty-six cents (\$43.56).
- 10. In order to renumerate Ms. Tortorici for acting as the Teacher of Record for Ms. Ellis's math classes, Ms. Tortorici will be paid an additional forty-eight dollars and fifty-six cents (\$43.56) per workday retroactive to March 20, 2024.
- 11. This additional remuneration will be included as part of Ms. Tortorici's weekly wages.
- 12. Ms. Tortorici will continue to enter student grades and plan lessons for Ms. Ellis's classes and will receive the additional remuneration until:
 - (a) Ms. Ellis returns to work; or
 - (b) upon mutual agreement between Ms. Tortorici, the Union and the Superintendent of Schools.

- 13. Accordingly, in the event that Ms. Tortorici ceases to act as the Teacher of Record for Ms. Ellis's math classes during the 2023-2024 school year, Ms. Tortorici will no longer receive the additional remuneration.
- 14. The Board and the Association agree that this Memorandum of Agreement and the terms set forth herein shall neither establish a past practice nor a precedent.
