## **Drug and Alcohol Testing for School Bus Drivers**

The Thomaston Public School district is committed to the establishment of a drug use and alcohol misuse prevention program that meets all applicable requirements of the OmnibusTransportation Employee Testing Act of 1991 (OTETA), as amended, and applicable state law related to preemployment and random drug testing of school bus drivers. The District shall adhere to federal lawand regulations requiring a school bus driver's drug and alcohol testing program.

The Thomaston Public Schools ensures the bus contractor has a drug and alcohol testing program fulfilling federal regulations and state law pertaining to a required pre-employment and random drug testing program for drivers of school buses and student transportation vehicles (STVs).
