Non-Discrimination/Notification of Grievance Procedures

It is the policy of the Thomaston Public Schools not to discriminate on the basis of handicap as required under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 in the admission of students to programs or any educational services or in the employment of personnel.
